



<p>Solution A liquid in which something has been dissolved, like sugar water.</p>		
<p>Solvent A substance (usually a liquid) that is used to dissolve another substance, or in which another substance is dissolved.</p>		
<p>Osmosis The process whereby a solvent, like water, passes through the membrane of a living cell into a solution of higher concentration in order to equalise the concentrations of solute on the two sides of the membrane.</p>		
<p>Dilute To make something thinner or less strong by adding water or another liquid to it.</p>		
<p>Solute A substance that is dissolved in another substance.</p>		
<p>Semi-Permeable Describes something that only lets certain things pass through it</p>		



Cell Membrane

A thin layer that protects and controls which substances can pass in or out of the cell.
