

## Textbooks in South Korea:

Public education from Grades 1 to 12 in South Korea is free, meaning there are no fees for tuitions, admission, and curriculum books (textbooks and instructional guides) among other expenses. Curriculum books are required to reflect the key elements of the curriculum; and they get published in both print and digital versions and accompanied by resources for both teachers and students. There are various publishers to choose textbooks from and each school has freedom to select textbooks their students will use. Each student receives their own textbooks for all subjects. Also, textbooks are affordable (\$2 ~ \$10 per textbook – depends on the subject area) and can be easily purchased and accessed from bookstores and via online.

- 3 Types of Textbooks (Ministry of Education):
  - a) Guk-jung Textbooks / "Government-designated" Textbooks
    - : The Ministry of Education (MOE) participates in developing textbooks and has the copyright.
  - b) Geom-jung Textbooks / "Government-authorized" Textbooks
    - : Published and written by private publishers and approved by the Ministry of Education
    - : Publishers must go through an inspection by the Minister of Education and their textbooks must acquire approval from the superintendent of education, a delegator of the Ministry of Education.
  - c) In-jung Textbooks / "Government-approved" Textbooks
    - : Published by private publishers and/or public district school boards
    - : These textbooks are used only when there are no textbooks available for specific subjects/topics from the government-designated or government-authorized textbooks.
    - : These textbooks are used as supplementary to the government-designated or authorized textbooks.
