<p>Traffic Jam A long line of vehicles that cannot move forward because there is too much traffic.</p>	<p>交通阻塞 由于交通过于拥挤，导致一长列车辆无法前行。</p>	
<p>Blood A circulatory system that contains important components and transport things around in the body.</p>	<p>血 一种循环系统，含有重要成分并在体内运输物质。</p>
