scale A standard for measuring something, such as using degrees for angles or cubic metres for area.	Examples: a) Degrees (25°) for angles b) Cubic metres (m³) for area c) Square metres (m²) for area
protractor	Protractor
An instrument used for measuring and drawing angles.	Protractor
acute angle An angle which is less than 90 degrees.	Acute angle < 90°
right angle An angle of 90 degrees.	Pool of the second seco

obtuse angle An angle between 90 and 180 degrees.	135 Obtuse angle 90°-180°
reflex angle An angle between 180 and 360 degrees.	185° Reflex angle 180°-360°
